 Say a prayer to God asking for forgiveness.

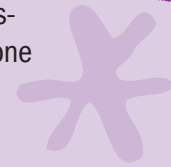

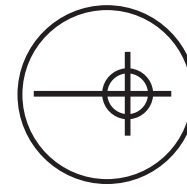
